Dear Parents:

Some students are having trouble remembering different necessities needed for class. I have created a checklist in order to make classes run smoother and for your child to feel more comfortable in class. Please make a note of what is needed. These are **MUST HAVES** in order for your child to get the most out of class and also to help his/her teachers. Here is a checklist:

- Appropriate shoes (jazz, tap, lyrical, hip hop, pompom (tennis shoes) – Please put names on all shoes
- Socks to be worn with ballet and tap shoes
- Hair tied back
- Dance shoes put in a bag with name on it
- Appropriate dance attire
- Socks, socks, sock (Makes getting shoes on much easier)
- Water bottle
- **Extra pony tail holders in dance bag**
- **Dance supplies if you haven't already brought them (paper towels, 5 ounce drinking, and box of Kleenex. This was listed in the student handbook given out at registration)**
- Winter coats/shoes/hats/mittens with names on them
